

- Always ring your local health clinic/GP and let them know you want to get tested.
- Lor COVID-19 test, you gor be asked por describe "where you feel sick?" (like coughing or short wind)
- You can ask the health staff wanem gor happen when you get lor clinic.
- You mus let thempla know if you need support when you get lor clinic, especially if you need help with walking or wheelchair or if you wandeh a carer/family member por come lor you.
- If you finish gedeh test and you waiting por test result, family and friend whoda come in contact with you don't need to be in quarantine unless the local public health unit tells them to.

## STEPS IN THE TEST:

- 1. The doctor or nurse gor take you to one testing room/area.
- 2. The doctor or nurse gor ask you por describe "where you feel sick?" (like lor chest or lor throat or if you head e hot lor fever) and ask you where and whotha you been in contact with.
- 3. You mus tell the doctor or nurse if you worry about family or workmates being sick from COVID-19.
- 4. You can ask your doctor or nurse if thempla gor test for any other viruses besides COVID-19.
- 5. The doctor or nurse gor meken the test, this test e done by collecting a nasal (inside lor nose) or throat swabs, or thempla gor ask another staff member por mekem.
- 6. The doctor or nurse gor spik you wanem gor happen after you mekeh the test.

## **AFTER THE TEST YOU:**

- The doctor or nurse might spik you por isolate por few days until you gedeh results back from your doctor.
- When you in isolation, you should have mina small contact with family members or gor out in public spaces.
- Maintain physical distancing of 1.5m or 2 arms-length away.
- Keep up lor good hygiene practices.
- If you nor bin gedeh test results within 48 hours or you feel more sick, contact your health centre again.
