

Halwyn Centre

About the Service

The Halwyn Centre is a Supported Independent Living (SIL) service which caters for NDIS participants who have complex high-care needs and require 24/7 care.

All our residents mobilise with a wheelchair and have varying levels of support requirements due to their individual impairments.

The centre has 20 permanent beds. No new permanent admissions are accepted. Halwyn Centre also provides short term accommodation for existing participants. No new respite admissions are accepted.

What services are available?

- 24-hour registered nursing care
- Activity coordinators in house
- Social work
- Speech therapy
- Dietetics
- Physiotherapy
- Occupational therapy
- Regular access to a Visiting Medical Officer (VMO) who is also available on call 24 hours a day.
- Individualised person-centred planning to care
- Access to external service providers for community access
- Meals
- Accommodation

Am I eligible for this service?

There are no permanent places available. We do offer a respite service for current respite clients only.
