## Applying and removing a flat surgical mask

## Applying a flat surgical mask




Clean your hands with soap and water or hand sanitiser before touching the mask.



Spread out the folds of the mask by pulling the top and bottom of the mask apart.



Hold the mask with the coloured side away from you. The side of the mask that has a stiff bendable edge should be at the top.





Tie up the top strings first in a bow at the back of your head. The top strings sit above your ears



Tie the bottom strings in a bow. Ensure the strings sit beneath your ears.



For surgical masks with ear loops, stretch elastic over both ears.



This is how your mask should be securely positioned. Be mindful that you do not touch the mask once you have it on.


## Removing a flat surgical mask



Clean your hands with soap and water or hand sanitiser before touching the mask. Avoid touching front of the mask.



Only touch the ear loops or ties.Hold both ear loops and gently lift and remove the mask.

Untie the top tie and pull the mask away from you as the ties are loosened.

Do not touch the front of the mask. Dispose of the mask.

Clean your hands with soap and water or hand sanitiser.
