

 Click on the ME tab in the top menu bar to find your list of allocated training under the heading Learning & Certifications







  - e. Infection Control Awareness non-clinical (25 mins)
  - f. Public Interest Disclosure (25 mins) currently not compatible with mobile
  - g. First Response Evacuation Instructions (25mins)
  - h. COVID-19 Cultural Orientation (25mins)
  - i. Health and Safety Orientation (30mins)
  - j. Healthcare Ergonomics Theory (30mins)
  - k. Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Cultural Practice Orientation (40mins)
