No new COVID-19 cases were recorded in Queensland today!

The two cases identified yesterday, both truck drivers who were as being under investigation, have been reclassified as negative cases.

This morning the Premier announced that starting midday today, there will be a pause on arrivals from New South Wales, Victoria and the ACT into Queensland for two weeks, due to pressure on the hotel quarantine system. Metro North remains on Tier 1
