### **EASY STEPS TO CONFIRM YOUR VACCINATION**



Download your vaccination certificate via your MyGov account or the Services Australia website, or photograph/scan the vaccination record wallet card you received at the vaccination clinic.



Go to hvh.health.qld.gov.au and login with your usual Queensland Health computer details to access the portal.



Check your personal information is correct and tick the "I am vaccinated" box.



Add your vaccination dates and type of vaccine – the dates are on your card or immunisation record.



Upload the proof of vaccination – your certificate or record card.



Preview and confirm the information is correct.



Click complete.

Lastly today, a reminder that information about <u>fit testing</u> and <u>staff testing locations</u> is available on the Metro North extranet site.
