Tier four status update


Metro North Health remains at <u>tier four</u> of our COVID response plan. Our COVID response tier will be reviewed and reassessed again tomorrow morning.

Across our health service today, there are **667** health workers and staff unable to attend work because of COVID-19 reasons. This continues to have significant impacts on many clinical areas.

We're grateful to the **107** staff who have agreed to come back to work through the Critically Essential Worker process. This process is not appropriate for everyone, but if you are a close contact and think it may be an option for you, please talk to your line manager.

COVID-19 staff debrief survey

Today, we're launching the next part of our debriefing process around our COVID-19 response. The <u>COVID-19 staff debrief survey</u> is a short questionnaire that asks for your reflections, feedback, and ideas about what we have learnt from the pandemic.
