Tier 3

With easing numbers of staff affected by COVID-19, this morning we have moved to <u>Tier 3</u> of our COVID-19 response plan. This means we will increase planned care but remain in the high-risk category for PPE requirements.

While this is welcome news, we must remain vigilant with social distancing, hand hygiene, PPE, and staying home if unwell. Face masks must be worn across Metro North facilities as part of Tier 3.

Face-to-face training can resume where essential with a focus on virtual training where possible.
