Current situation

Metro North remains in <u>Tier 3</u> of our COVID response plan. We have made some minor updates to our Tier 3 plan to suit the current situation. These changes include:

- Optimise virtual meetings and virtual training
- Face to face meetings acceptable for crucial safety and quality meetings
- Face to face training acceptable only for essential training e.g., OVP, fire warden, QLS, BLS, and for at the elbow education support in clinical areas to support junior staff

Today we have 441 staff out of the workplace as close contacts or with COVID.
