P2/N95 masks are required by staff within 1. Emergency Departments 2. COVID ICU Pods 3. Isolation Wards 4. where close contacts are cohorted 5. where COVID cases are cohorted.

Other units may continue with P2/N95 in conjunction with local Infection Management assessment and guidance. Individuals can go up a level of PPE but cannot go down a level.
