As part of Accreditation preparation, TPCH along with other directorates, is required to undergo a Peer Review every 12 months.

TPCH's Peer Review, being led by Metro North's Executive Director Clinical Governance, Grant Carey-Ide will run tomorrow, **Tuesday 2 July and Wednesday 3 July**.

As part of this process, 14 peer assessors will be on site visiting selected areas throughout the hospital.

Areas of focus are likely to include:

- Hand hygiene
- Bare below the elbows
- Mask wearing
- Storage of consumables
- Mandatory training e.g. fire safety.

The peer assessors will also speak to patients, relatives, visitors and staff to find out more about their experiences at TPCH.
