#### **Ben Jeffrey Memorial Award**

This service will work in partnership with the Ngarrama Service to provide support to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander women and families through all stages of their journey with a focus on holistic, culturally sensitive, multidisciplinary integrated services.

The Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Perinatal Wellbeing service will work across the three satellite hospitals with Kallangur and Bribie Island still under development, due to open in the coming year.
