Dear Staff,

It is an exciting month for the RBWH Community Mental Health Services as we prepare to move to our new premises at 121 Wharf St, Spring Hill. The Spring Hill Community Mental Health Centre (SHCMHS) will bring together our multidisciplinary team of 180 staff to provide our consumers with mental health care from a modern environment, in one space.

After more than 30 years, the Inner North Brisbane Mental Health Service (INBMHS) will relocate from Fortitude Valley to the new Spring Hill location in late April. This will be followed by the OPD clinics currently housed on E Floor Mental Health Centre and the staff from Pye House and Lawrence House (MIRT and MH Resource Team) all moving in May and the Older Persons Mental Health staff relocating in June.

The Spring Hill Community Mental Health Centre will provide consumers with a modern community clinic that promotes mental health and wellbeing. The Centre will better accommodate the growth of our clinics and workforce, enhancing our response to the increasing demand for mental health care. The consumer accessible space includes dedicated consult and treatment spaces and consumer group rooms.

The new office fit out is looking great and will provide staff with a modern office environment and new and open kitchen facilities.
