As we draw closer to go-live and continue progressing on our integrated electronic Medical Record (ieMR) learning and proficiency journey, there will be a number of knowledge maintenance opportunities available to complete. **From Monday, 3 March 2025, ieMR scenarios will be commencing.**

Scenarios are in-person, walk-through demonstrations of specific end-to-end workflows, incorporating ieMR devices, and are designed to enhance staff proficiency in commonly-used areas of the ieMR.

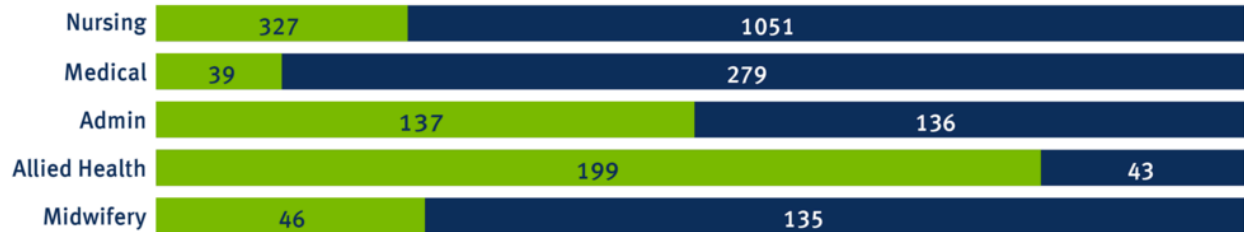

We continue to make excellent progress in completing ieMR training. As of today, 32 percent of CKW staff have completed all their ieMR training and proficiency, with the breakdown by staffing cohort below.
