

Hi CKW team,

As I'm sure everyone will be aware of by now (you can scarcely walk a few metres in the hospital without seeing any), the signage supporting our integrated electronic Medical Record (ieMR) golive at Caboolture Hospital was installed last week.

This is a key pre go-live milestone for us, signifying just how close we are to our ieMR transition. It's been lovely seeing everyone pointing out a colleague featured in the signage, grabbing a selfie, or having a jump on an ieMR hopscotch.



Notwithstanding how exciting it is seeing the go-live signage across the hospital, it's an important reminder of just how close we are to go-live on 7 May 2025.

Training is an absolutely **crucial** focus for us right now. As of today, only 54 percent of staff have completed their required ieMR training. It is essential that **all** staff training is completed prior to go-live.

Please see below the breakdown of training completions by professional stream.



If you are required to complete instructor-led ieMR training and have not yet been booked for a session, please speak to your line manager about this as soon as possible (ASAP).

Our ieMR Program Training Team colleagues have established weekend training sessions to accommodate those who may not be able to attend training during the week.

If you are struggling to find time to complete online training via <u>Talent Management System (TMS)</u> (if required for your role) – speak to your line manager about time that can be set aside for you to do so.

If you're unsure what training you are required to complete, or don't know when your training is occurring, please speak with your line manager as an urgent priority.
