During this final stretch, training completion is our number one priority.

It is essential that all staff training is completed prior to go-live on Wednesday, 7 May 2025. If you are struggling to find time to complete the online component of your training via Talent Management System (TMS), please speak with your line manager so they can help set aside a suitable time for you to do so.

As of today, 65 per cent of staff have completed all their mandatory integrated electronic Medical Record (ieMR) training, with the breakdown by professional stream below.
