Dear team,

Construction of the new 1500-space multi-storey car park at TPOCH is nearing completion, with the facility expected to open from **June 2025**.

As we prepare for the opening, staff car parking applications will open on **Monday 26 May 2025** via a Microsoft Form. Detailed information about the process and a link to the form will be shared next week. Keep an eye out for the special car parking message on 26 May.

We expect a high volume of interest in staff parking and spaces may be limited, dependent on demand, so we strongly encourage staff to apply as early as possible. **This is your opportunity to secure a space ahead of changes to parking across the campus.**

As part of this transition, boom gates and paid access will be introduced across all existing staff car parks on site. If you drive to work and would like to access undercover staff parking, it's important to apply during this window.

Please share this update with colleagues who may be on leave or working offsite during this time.

Once the application window is closed and finalised, next steps will be advised.

**Importantly, by submitting an application, you are confirming your commitment to take up a space in the new car park if one is offered.**
