There will be a trivia competition and staff scavenger hunt with lots of cryptic and clever clues, and Race to the Roof will be run on Tuesday 24 June.

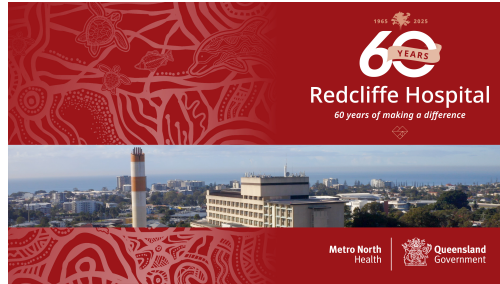
