2026 RBWH Research Project Grants

Applications for Research Project Grants, funded by the RBWH Study, Education and Research Trust Account (SERTA) Advisory Committee, are currently open to RBWH researchers (staff and consumers) for research project funding commencing in 2026.

Applications should propose innovative and original research that has the potential to:

- Directly affect the care provided to RBWH patients, including translational research and new models of care
- Foster collaborations across RBWH departments, and/or between RBWH and other facilities and external partners
- Support development of early career researchers.

The 2026 RBWH Research Project Grant scheme round will consist of two categories:

- \$50,000 Research project grants (i.e. applications from \$15,001 to \$50,000) with funding available for 24-months. Up to 10 projects will be awarded in this category.
- \$25,000 Research project grants (i.e. applications up to \$25,000) with funding available for 24-months. Up to 6 projects will be awarded in this category.

Key dates

- Applications close: 4 August 2025
- Outcomes communicated: late November 2025

The 2025 Herston Health Precinct Symposium will be held from Monday 1 to Wednesday, 3 September, in the Main Auditorium of the Education Centre, RBWH, with the option for online attendance on Microsoft Teams.

The event theme is *Advancing Health Together*, reflecting the partnerships and research collaborations across the 30+ health facilities, medical research institutes, universities and organisations that comprise the Herston Health Precinct and the focus on translational research that improves health outcomes for our community, locally and globally.

We have a fantastic program on offer and encourage you to attend as much of the event as possible, to network with and learn from others, support your research colleagues and celebrate the research achievements on the Herston campus.
