August is Metro North Safety & Quality Month, and the Safety & Quality team want everyone to know that the Patient Reported Experience Measures (PREMs) survey is returning to the Emergency Department.

PREMs is an online survey sent to patients 48 hours after they are discharged. PREMs asks patients about their care, and those responses give us important insight into how we can improve that care for everyone.

The plan is for PREMs to be rolled out again to inpatient areas later this year and to outpatient clinics in early 2026.


