Dear colleagues

We had some more good news this week in relation to the Redcliffe Hospital Expansion. On Monday morning, we welcomed the Health Minister, Hon Tim Nicholls MP back to Redcliffe, where he [announced](#) that Richard Crookes Construction will deliver an additional three levels of car parking to the hospital's multi-storey car park, with work to begin early next year.

The Minister also confirmed the Expansion will deliver at least 210 new overnight beds and protect the Aboriginal scar tree.

As part of the media event, the Minister also released two new artists' impressions of what the hospital campus may look like when the new Clinical Services Building (CSB) is complete.

Wishlist Grant applications
