Medical imaging continues to play a pivotal role in patient flow, and this week, I'm pleased to talk about a [new medical imaging department](#) coming to the Brighton Health Campus that will be good for patients and good for our hospital.

Our medical imaging team here at Redcliffe (pictured) is playing a leading role in developing this new purpose-built medical imaging service, as part of the Statewide MRI and CT Expansion Program.

The new medical imaging department at Brighton will offer a full suite of contemporary imaging modalities including CT, MRI, ultrasound and X-ray, with onsite radiology reporting.

Being located at Brighton, the new service will help improve patient access – without patients needing to come to a hospital like Redcliffe.



The new service will help reduce wait times for patients and help to reduce clinical pressure on our medical imaging department – all while giving patients access to the diagnostic technology they need, closer to home.
