Dear Team,

Every year, I am impressed by the professional and dedicated work of our Building, Engineering and Maintenance Service (BEMS) team across all our 30 plus sites.

Their diligence, performance and responsiveness to service priorities and completion of backlog maintenance are outstanding.

Across the past year, close to \$7 million has been expended including upgrades across Cooinda House, Redcliffe, North West, Nundah and Pine Rivers Community Health Centres, Brighton Health Campus, Zillmere Residential Transition Care and oral health clinics at Stafford, Sandgate, Kippa Ring and Humpybong.

Improvements have included:

- replacing bathroom linings and fittings,
- landscaping
- carpet and vinyl replacement,
- roof repair,
- significant electrical work,
- replacement of doors, lighting and handrails,
- Other safety initiatives and updates.

On top of that is the major work is currently underway at 19th Avenue, Brighton.

External assessors always commend the backlog maintenance program and the excellent condition of the aged infrastructure.

Most importantly, this work benefits our staff, families and the people in our care.
