Dear colleagues,

The Multi-Storey Car Park Expansion has achieved another milestone, with the opening of the new car park entry earlier this week. Relocating the car park entry (pictured) and exit was important to enable works for both the Multi-Storey Car Park Expansion and the Redcliffe Hospital Expansion.

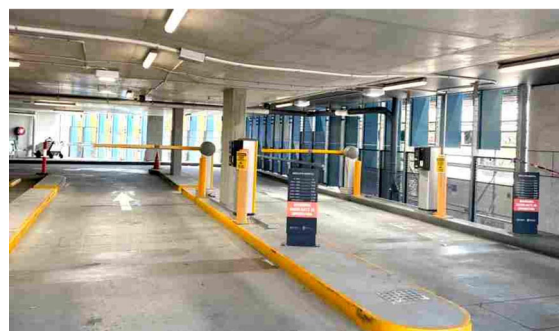
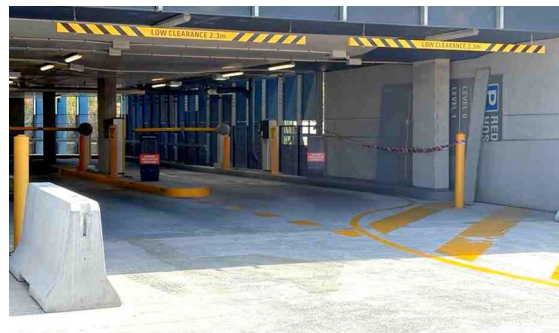
The next milestone comes on Monday, when 250 car parks on Level 3 and parts of Level 2 will close for the next three months. This will put significant pressure on the car park, but it's necessary to allow builders to safely commence construction.

To support parking availability during this time, temporary arrangements are being put in place for the Redcliffe Showgrounds staff car park.

From Monday, parking at the Showgrounds will be free for three months for existing Showgrounds users and eligible day-shift staff transferring from the multi-storey car park to the Showgrounds.

Showgrounds access is available to existing car park pass holders only, and will remain available until capacity is reached.

The Showgrounds staff car park is open from 5am to 6pm, Monday to Friday (pictured below).



Shift workers who currently have a multi-storey car park pass may use the Showgrounds, free of charge, during day shifts for three months. Shift workers can continue to use the multi-storey for afternoon and night shifts, at the usual staff rate.



By encouraging day shift staff to park at the Showgrounds, we'll relieve parking pressure and ensure parking availability for afternoon and night shift staff.

Education Centre AV upgrade

Over the coming weeks, the Education Centre's audio-visual system will be upgraded with new technology.

The Education Centre plays an important role in supporting clinical education and staff training. It also serves as the hospital's Emergency Operations Centre and hosts many of our major events each year.

To enable the installation of new cabling and equipment, parts of the Education Centre will be closed from next week with the entire Centre closed for much of October.

Over recent weeks, Kerri Wilson has worked closely with teams and hospital areas to identify alternative dates and venues for training and events. With the lecture rooms booked heavily and used by so many different teams, she's done a great job with this big task.

Thank you also to everyone who has agreed to be flexible and moved meetings and training onto Teams where possible.

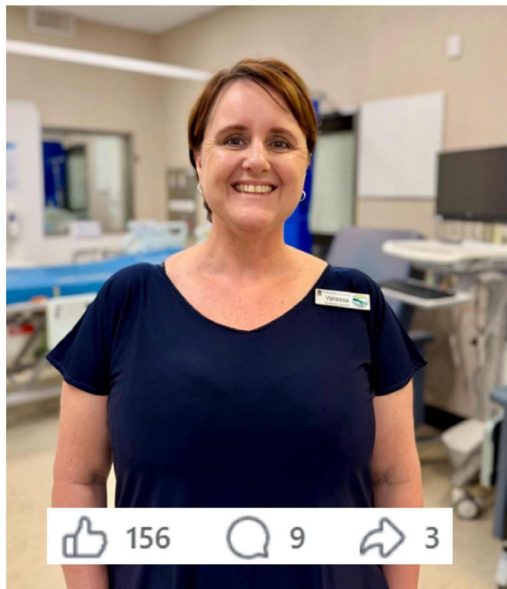

Every year at Redcliffe Hospital, thousands of elective and emergency surgeries take place across the seven theatres, with Clinical Nurse Vanessa keeping them all on schedule.

Vanessa has worked at Redcliffe for 20 years, with the theatre bookings space providing her a chance to help patients with their concerns during what can be a difficult time.

"We cover lots of areas, we organise both elective and emergency surgeries as well as outsourcing for Surgery Connect patients," Vanessa said.

"We can assist people with inter-hospital transfers, confirmation calls, any queries that patients may have and ensuring the surgical wait list is managed so patients are being treated on time."
