Dr. Hermann Oberli completed his general surgery training in Switzerland after studying at the Universities of Bern and Basel. He began his career as Head of the Surgical Department in Meiringen, Switzerland, before taking on international roles as a surgeon in Afghanistan and later as Chief Surgeon in Samoa. In addition to his work with the ICRC, the Swiss Red Cross, and the Disaster Relief Corps, Dr. Oberli served at Honiara Hospital in the Solomon Islands from 1993 to 2003, including during the civil unrest from 1999 to 2003. During this time, he played a key role in establishing an orthopaedic training program (PIOA). Since returning to Switzerland, Dr. Oberli has gained deep insight in low resourced countries and continued to visit Honiara regularly, supporting the ongoing improvement of trauma care in the Solomon Islands.
