## **Parking**

### 1. RBWH Carpark Point Parking (closest carpark to main entrance)

Location: 20 Butterfield Street, Herston. Contact: (07) 3252 4333

There is an undercover walkway connecting the carpark to level 1 Ned Hanlon building.

<u>Parking fees:</u> up to 2 hours \$26.40; or up to 7 hours: \$47. Please note these rates may change.


### 2. Royal Brisbane Carpark (Cornerstone Parking)

Location: 43 Butterfield Street, Herston. Contact: (07) 3034 0534

This is approximately a 3-minute walk from the main entrance to the hospital.

<u>Parking fees:</u> up to 2 hours \$23; or maximum daily fee of \$40. Please note these rates may change.

#### Park 'n' ride


There are many buses from the Brisbane Transit Centre / Roma Street Busway Station that will take you to the RBWH.

Approximate cost from Roma Street Busway Station: \$5.10 full fare (\$2.60 concession).

<u>Approximate travel time:</u> 20 minutes but allow 1 hour from arrival at Brisbane Transit Centre and your appointment time at the RBWH.

## From the airport

#### **Airtrain**

- Departs every 30 minutes from the domestic airport
- Travel time is approximately 28 minutes to Roma Street Station
- Cost is approximately \$20.90 one way (full fare) to Roma Street Station
- From Roma Street Station, take a bus to the RBWH

#### **Taxis**

- Approximately 15 minutes from the airport with good traffic
- Approximate cost is \$47
- Drop you off at main entrance of the hospital

Physiotherapy Department, Level 2 Ned Hanlon Building

 Enter the green lifts or take the main stair-case on ground floor up to level 2.



2. When you exit the lifts, turn **left**. Follow the signs to the physiotherapy reception. Check yourself in with our friendly staff and then have a seat in our waiting room.
