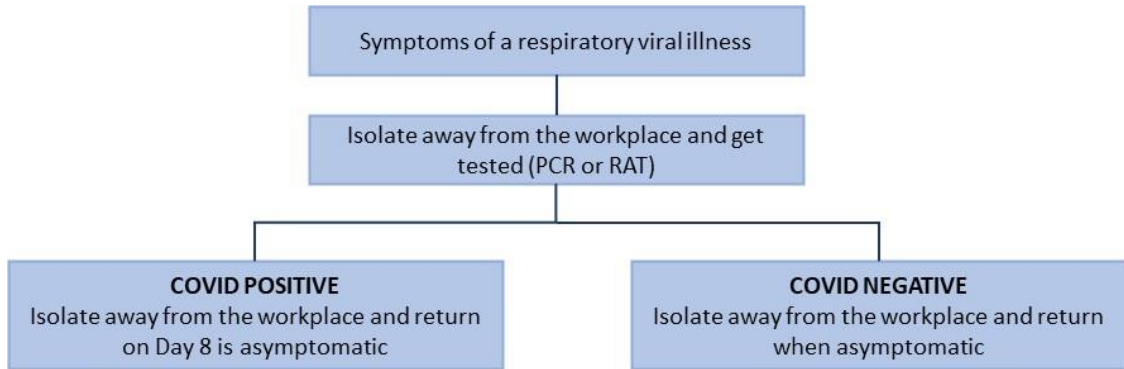


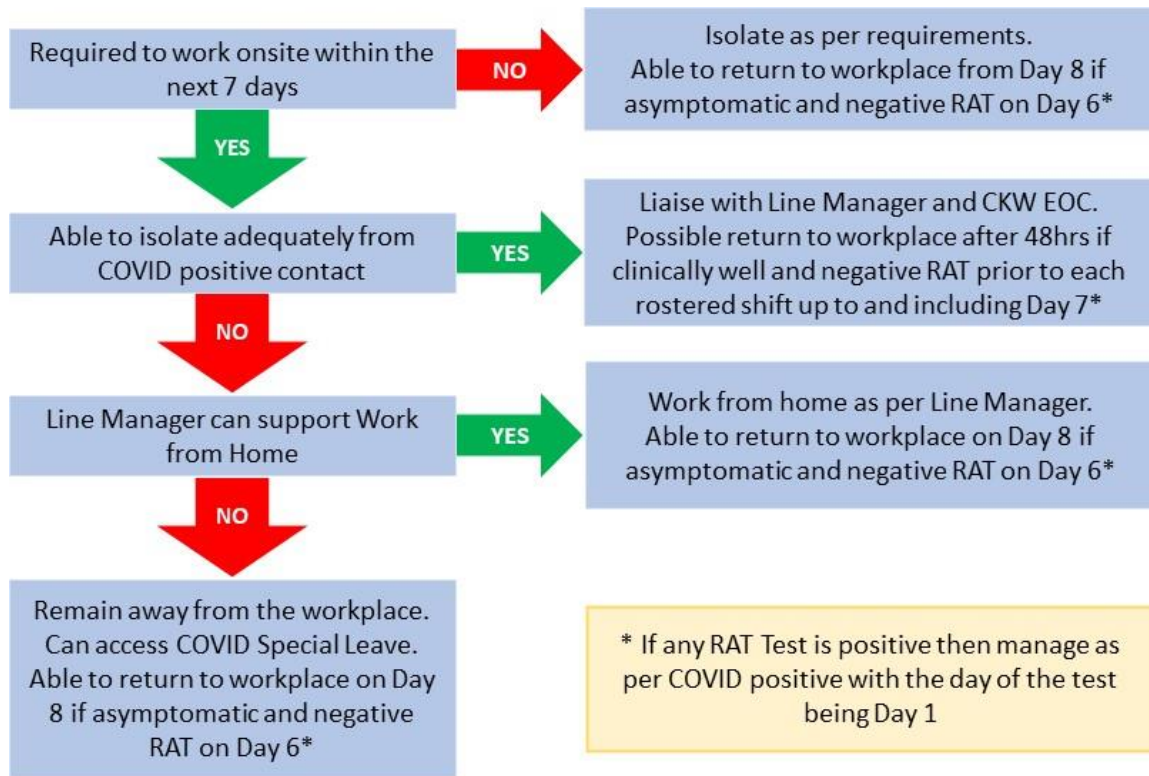
COVID-19 Testing Guide for CKW Staff

What do I do if I have symptoms of a respiratory viral illness?



Please register your COVID-19 positive result from a RAT via the [government reporting website](#)

What do I do if I am a close contact of a COVID positive person?



* If any RAT Test is positive then manage as per COVID positive with the day of the test being Day 1

I am symptomatic and need to get tested – where do I go?

There are a number of dedicated testing clinics for staff and their household contacts:

- Caboolture Hospital Staff Carpark – 7 days – 7.30am to 3.30pm
- TPCH Outpatients B – Monday to Friday – 7am to 2pm
- RBWH Education Centre – 7 days – 9am to 4pm

I am a close Contact and require a RAT – where can I get one?

- Caboolture Hospital Staff Testing Clinic (Staff Carpark) – 7 days – 7:30am to 3:30pm

CKW staff unable to attend a staff testing clinic may be able to coordinate a drive through RAT collection service.

- Monday to Friday 8am to 5pm – Phone CKW EOC on 5316 5014
- The After-Hours Nurse Manager office may be contacted via switch in urgent cases where access to a RAT is required for critical service delivery continuity after hours

Can I get a free RAT testing kit to have at home just in case?

Due to limited supply of RAT kits, MN can only provide free RAT kits for staff that are confirmed close contacts and require a test to support a return to the workplace.
