Frequently Asked Questions

Where can I park?

450 paid car parking spaces are located beneath the STARS building and are available for staff, patients, visitors and families.

There are no complimentary parking spots available near STARS. Multi-storey undercover car parks available within the Herston Health Precinct are:

All car parks are all privately owned and charges will apply. Visit their websites for rates and opening times.

Additional parking will become available in future, including the new 1150-space Northern Car Park (yet to be built).

Is there on street parking near STARS?

Yes. Metered parking is available on streets near STARS. Parking in these areas is regulated by Brisbane City Council.

Is there a patient drop off area?

Yes. A short-term drop-off and pick up zone is available at the main entrance of STARS. The drop-off and pick up zone can be accessed by driving to 296 Herston Road, Herston.

Are there any disabled parking spaces?

Yes. 30 disabled and short term car parking bays are available at STARS.

Are concessions available?

Patients or their primary carer may be eligible for discounted parking where commercial car parking fees apply. Can I use public transport to get to STARS?

Yes. Busways and bus stops are located only a short walk away from STARS, including:

- Herston Busway (opposite STARS) – buses including 66, 333, 330 and 340 service this stop regularly.
- Herston Road near Bramston Terrace – buses including 360 service
- RBWH Busway – buses including 375 and those servicing Herston busway.
- Bramston Terrace at Weightman Street Stop 9

The nearest train stations are Fortitude Valley Station or Bowen Hills Station. Both stations are about a 1-2km (or a 20 minute) walk to STARS.

From 2025 the future Cross River Rail project will provide rail services to Exhibition Station all year round.

Is STARS accessible from Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital?

Yes. A link bridge is available to connect pedestrians from RBWH to STARS. From the RBWH Ned Hanlon building, take the lift to level six to access the link bridge through to Level 3 STARS.
