Uniform Services at the Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital will fit and supply uniforms for STARS nurses.

To arrange a fitting, an appointment is required.

A *Nursing and Midwifery Uniform Order Approval Form* needs to be completed by line manager and forwarded to Uniform Services via email to order your uniform and confirm appointment. Hard copy of form must also be brought to appointment. Please note there may be a four (4) to six (6) week wait for delivery following fitting.

About Allocation of Uniforms

Full time employees are entitled to an allocation of uniforms (including scrubs) to the value of 5 culottes and 5 shirts (selected from the range available via Standing Offer Arrangement [SOA] 601).

Nurses/midwives can select any combination of uniform pieces available in the SOA 601, including scrubs.

Part time and casual nurses/midwives will be issued with a pro rata allocation of uniforms. (Queensland Health Nurses and Midwives Award – State 2012, Clause 5.5) NB

All nursing/midwifery staff are to be issued with one (1) 'formal' uniform (not scrubs) for use when official representation of MNHHS nursing/midwifery is required, as part of their allocation.
