The Surgical, Treatment and Rehabilitation Service (STARS) is a new public hospital located on Herston Road. This new state-of-the-art building is located directly across from the Herston Bus Station (former location of the Royal Children's Hospital).

Here's what you need to know about your upcoming appointment:

While STARS is a new standalone facility, a few of the Specialist Outpatient Services provided by the Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital have relocated to Level 3 of the STARS building.


Relocated Specialist Outpatient Services include:

- Tess Cramond Pain and Research Centre
- Rheumatology
- Dermatology

Location and Transport


Location: 296 Herston Road, Herston

 Patients may be dropped off at the STARS Main Entrance on Herston Road.

** Patients dropped off at RBWH Main Entrance will need to be redirected to STARS, which may require a 12 minute (900m) walk.*

 Paid parking is available within the STARS building, or alternatively Bramston Terrace or at Cornerstone Parking on Herston Road.

 STARS is opposite the Herston Busway Station and an 8 minute (550m) walk from the RBWH Busway Station.

 Nearest train stations are Fortitude Valley Station (2km) or Bowen Hills Station (2km), both are about a 20 minute walk to STARS.
