We encourage family and friends to visit patients during their stay. Children accompanied by an adult are also most welcome. Please check with staff about visiting hours, therapy, and rest schedules if you are unsure when will be the best time to visit.

Ward 5A

Ward 5A is a secure ward. Visitors can access the ward by pressing the intercom button on the left of the entry door. After entering, please close the door. To exit, see one of the team who can unlock the door for you.



Visiting Patients After a Brain Injury

Some patients may need to have a low stimulus environment to help them with their recovery. At times it may be required to limit the number of visitors per day or the number of people visiting at any one time.

Accessing the Hospital After Hours

Access to the hospital is restricted between 9pm and 6am. Where access is required outside of these hours, security can be contacted via the intercoms that are based at each of the entrances to STARS.
