## **CICM Training Requirements**

Basic Training (3 years)	A total of 3 years including any combination of internal medicine, anaesthesia or intensive care. Up to 12 months as an elective will also be recognized. The elective can be in medicine, surgery, anaesthesia, intensive care, research or other approved disciplines.	CICM or other CICM recognized Primary examination must be successfully completed before moving to advanced training.
	A minimum of 12 months intensive care in an accredited ICU (basic or core) must be completed in basic training	
Advanced Training (3 years)	Complete any remaining training time in Internal Medicine (12 months), Anaesthesia (12 months) and elective (12 months)	ADAPT Workshop
	24 months core intensive care training must be completed in advanced training: a minimum of 12 months in a Level 3 intensive care unit with CICM C24 accreditation status; 12 months must be continuous in a unit accredited for core training.	Research Project
	The final 6 months of ICU training must be in a Senior Registrar position.	Pass the CICM Fellowship Examination
