


Keeping Kidneys in the Community:

This active learning module aims to assist participants in building capacity and confidence in prevention, early detection and management of Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD).



The workshop will provide a unique opportunity for primary care to build partnerships with Metro North Kidney Health Service clinicians.

CKD is a 'silent disease' that affects 10 per cent of the Australian population and causes more deaths than breast cancer or prostate cancer each year. However, patients with CKD are often underdiagnosed and consequently identified at the advanced stages of the disease.

Funded by Metro North Hospital and Health Service, the Metro North CKD shared care is an innovative initiative taking person centred care at its core to improve the care and outcomes for patients with or at risk of CKD.
