Advanced Life Support - Level 1

- One-day course providing candidates with the skills and knowledge to manage the patient in the immediate period of crisis
- Practical workshops and simulations providing skills for management of the deteriorating patient and cardiac arrest including airway management, basic life support and safe defibrillation
- Course is approved by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) and provides certification recognised in Australia, New Zealand and Europe, valid for 4 years

- 2-day course focusing on developing advanced skills in managing the deteriorating patient and cardiac arrest
- Practical workshops and simulations providing skills including airway management, safe defibrillation, management of lifethreatening arrhythmias and leading a cardiac arrest team
- The course is very intensive, and candidates are sent the ALS 2
 Manual one month prior to the course. Candidates are required to
 complete a pre-course multiple choice question paper to guide
 preparation
- Course is approved by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) and provides certification recognised in Australia, New Zealand and Europe, valid for 4 years
