Changes to Building 6 Entry and Parking

The Prince Charles Hospital is undergoing a major expansion.

Parking and the entry point into Building 6 has changed.

Building 6 includes the following services:

- Cancer Care
- Palliative Care
- Cognitive Assessment and Management (CAM) Unit
- Adult Cystic Fibrosis Centre
- Cystic Fibrosis Outpatients
- · Outpatients Teal
- · Children's Allied Health Clinics

General access to Building 6 is 7 days a week between 5:30am to 9:00pm.

Car parking

Public car park 1 (the multi-storey car park) is next to the main entrance of the hospital, accessed via Rode Road. It is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Pick-up and drop-off zone

There is a pick-up and drop-off zone at the main entrance of the hospital, via Rode Road.

From the main entrance, follow signs to **Building 6**. If arriving after 5.00pm, use the intercom at the main entrance of the hospital and security will arrange an escort to take you to Building 6.

Courtesy shuttle bus

The courtesy shuttle bus runs from 7.30am to 5.30pm Monday to Friday, excluding public holidays. It runs on a 20-minute loop with five designated pick-up and drop-off points:

Stop 1:	Hospital Main Entry
Stop 2:	Gastro/ Endoscopy
Stop 3:	CAM and Outpatients Teal
Stop 4:	Cancer Care and Adult Cystic Fibrosis Centre
Stop 5:	Palliative Care

Charlie's Angel volunteers

The Charlie's Angels volunteers support all areas of TPCH and are available between 7.30am and 3.00pm to give a helping hand to patients and visitors.

Charlie's Angels can help by:

- directing and escorting patients to Building 6
- greeting patients at the front entrance and helping with their access into the hospital
- · patient visits.

Transit Lounge

Some patients may require additional nursing care to transfer Building 6. TPCH staff will support your admission to the Transit Lounge.

Visitor access after-hours (9.00pm to 5.30am)

Intercom at main hospital entrance

Visitors arriving after 9pm can use the intercom at the main entrance of the hospital and security will arrange an escort to take you to Building 6.

Return to main entrance after 5.00pm

Escort to front main entry

To return to the main entrance after 5.00pm, please speak with staff in the clinical area for support and an escort to the main entrance.


External footpath
