Advanced Life Support – Level 1

- One-day course providing candidates with the skills and knowledge to manage the patient in the immediate period of crisis.
- Practical workshops and simulations providing skills for management of the deteriorating patient and cardiac arrest including airway management, basic life support and safe defibrillation.
- Course is approved by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) and provides certification recognised in Australia, New Zealand, and Europe, valid for 4 years Advanced Life Support - Level 1

Advanced Life Support – Level 2

- 2-day course focusing on developing advanced skills in managing the deteriorating patient and cardiac arrest.
- Practical workshops and simulations providing skills including airway
 management, safe defibrillation, management of life threatening arrhythmias
 and leading a cardiac arrest team.
- The course is very intensive, and candidates are sent the ALS 2 Manual one month prior to the course. Candidates are required to complete a pre-course multiple choice question paper to guide preparation.
- Course is approved by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) and provides certification recognised in Australia, New Zealand and Europe, valid for 4 years.

Doctors and nurses working in critical care areas (e.g. ED, ICU, CCU) or in the resuscitation / medical emergency team and paramedics
