Organise the body of the abstract as follows: (a) Introduction, (b) Methods, (c) Results, (d) Conclusions, and (e) a limited number of references. Use standard abbreviations and generic drug names. Place non-standard abbreviations or acronyms in parentheses after first use. Do not identify author(s) or institution(s) in the text. Abstracts are to be text only.
