For over 40 years Maggie has had a remarkable career; author of 10 cook books, awarded Senior Australian of the Year in 2010, South Australian of the Year in 2011, appointed a member of the Order of Australia (AM) in 2012 and made a Doctor of Business honoris causa from Macquarie University in 2013. Maggie's career encompasses farming, food production, television presenting and advocacy, and in 2016 Maggie was awarded an honorary Doctorate by Uni SA for her contribution to South Australian tourism. 2014 saw the beginning of the Maggie Beer Foundation, the primary focus is to radically change food practices in aged care, to improve the emotional wellbeing of each and every person.
