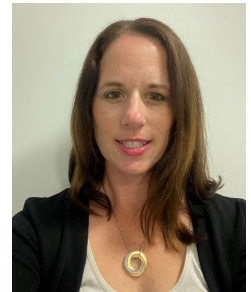
- Considerations and processes for research in virtual care setting
