# Background

### **Call for Abstracts**

Options for presentations include:

- 1. Oral presentation (8-10 minutes)
- 2. Lightning talk (3-5 minutes)
- 3. E-poster

Please indicate your preference in the Abstract Submission Form for consideration by the Scientific Committee, though note that you may be offered any presentation type. Presentation types are also subject to change at the discretion of the Symposium Organising Committee.

### Awards

At the Symposium conclusion, awards will be presented in the following categories, based on abstract and presentation scores: (1) Best oral presentation; (2) Best lightning presentation; and (3) Best e-poster.
