Enrolling, accessing, and progressing through the modules

- 1. Proceed with the following instructions AFTER you have registered for an ilearn account (nonQH learners). QH learners can access iLearn using their Novell login.
- 2. Select the relevant course catalogue and search for *Spirometry Education (year).*
