

QHSTP Navigating the Spirometry Education

Enrolling, accessing, and progressing through the modules

1. Proceed with the following instructions **AFTER** you have registered for an iLearn account (nonQH learners). QH learners can access iLearn using their Novell login.

2. Select the relevant course catalogue and search for *Spirometry Education (year)*.



5. You will receive a reply to the email address that you used to request enrolment. You are now ready to launch the course.

About the QH Spirometry Training Program

About the program

This program has been developed in consultation with the Queensland Health Statewide Respiratory Clinical Network and is comprised of three component:

- The Online Spirometry Education
- The Spirometry Practical Skills Workshop
- The Workplace Portfolio Assessment

Overall aims

- To improve the quality of Spirometry currently performed clinically throughout Queensland
- To increase the number of health professionals within Queensland capable of performing quality Spirometry which meets recognised standards

Program completion

Upon successful completion of all three components of the Spirometry Training Program, clinicians will be awarded a certificate of completion. Spirometry refresher courses will need to be undertaken to maintain currency of practice. The frequency of refresher training is regulated in some industries.

Important note

Completion of all three components of the Spirometry Training Program does not qualify participants to train and award competency to other staff. Competency can only be awarded by endorsed spirometry trainers and assessors.






Module 1 - Introduction to spirometry




Welcome to **Introduction to Spirometry**, the first module in the Spirometry Education Package which has been developed to support clinicians in conducting spirometry with both adults and children.
