As well as working there, she runs 3 monthly outreach clinics to Longreach. In addition, Claire is a Director of Redcliffe and Northside Rheumatology with her long-time friend and colleague, Dr Laurel Young. Claire's special interests include the optimal management of pregnancy in RA and addressing

the disadvantages that Australian regional rheumatology patients suffer, including by the use of telehealth. She is a Senior Lecturer at University of Queensland with regular teaching commitments to undergraduates and is also current President of the Australian Rheumatology Association (ARA)
