



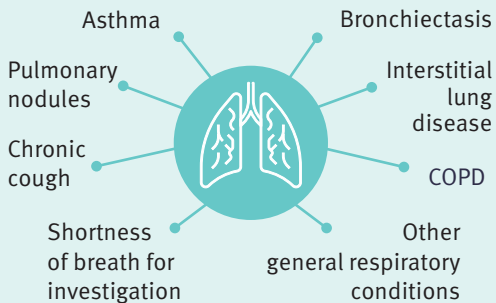
## A new specialist respiratory shared service model for First Nations people closer to home

The UROC Program will deliver culturally appropriate patient-centred care to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, in partnership between Metro North Health and the Institute for Urban Indigenous Health (IUIH).

Metro North Health specialist respiratory team will deliver clinics at Moreton Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Community Health Service (MATSICHS) centres in Margate and Morayfield. Lung function testing will be offered on site.

The UROC Program is available for adults who identify as Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander requiring a specialist respiratory service.
