For urgent care 7 days a week, visit the Minor Injury and Illness Clinic.

Got a cut, burn, or suspected fracture or dislocation? A minor head injury with no loss of consciousness? A sting, or an eye, throat, or ear problem?

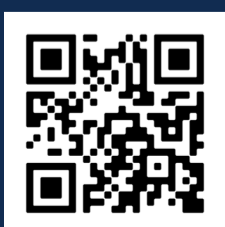
The Minor Injury and Illness Clinics provide **walk-in urgent care** for people whose injury or illness is not anticipated to be life-threatening.

- Walk-ins, no appointments necessary
- Open 8.00am to 10.00pm 7 days a week
- Onsite x-ray
- FREE car parking
- Located adjacent to the Caboolture and Kallangur train stations
- FREE for Medicare Card holders.

One of the major differences between emergency departments and urgent care clinics is the severity of the health problems they treat. If the condition is life-threatening and you require immediate medical attention, go to an emergency department.

Urgent care facilities provide expert medical attention for everything from the flu to minor fractures and injuries but are not appropriate in emergency situations when life is at stake.
