This Extracorporeal Life Support Organsiation endorsed course will enable multidisciplinary teams with little ECMO experience to gain knowledge and skills to provide ECMO for patients with severe cardiac and respiratory failure. The course curriculum is designed to allow participants to train in a safe, team environment and learn the technical and nontechnical skills needed to provide high quality ECMO care. This course is for specialist doctors and trainees, nurses, perfusionists and allied health professionals involved in provision of ECMO.

The core components include:
