The chance to attend this KSC Masterclass with their admission ticket being paid (value of \$170). With potential for an additional sum of \$400 to be provided to those applicants who do not live in Brisbane or who live interstate to partially cover flights and accommodation costs that will be incurred to attend the Brisbane event (**note funding will only be provided post event, not before).



Applicant Criteria:

- Applicants can be from any discipline (e.g., medical, nursing, allied health, researcher, or other health care worker role)
- Must identify as Aboriginal and/or Torries Strait Islander.
- Directly work with people living with advanced chronic kidney disease.

Have a key interest in KSC and are looking to increase their knowledge and skillset on the core curriculum topics of KSC to integrate key learning within their local workplace.

Application Process:

Interested applicants who meet the above criteria should:

- Submit a small paragraph, no more than 200 words explaining:
- 1. What areas of KSC are you aiming to enhance your knowledge on and why.
- 2. Describe how you plan to share this new knowledge with your colleagues in your local work
- 3. How you anticipate this education will improve patient outcomes.
